CAER CARADOC

Caer Caradoc is a distinctive hill of volcanic rock 1500ft (459m) high overlooking the Shropshire town of Church Stretton. It offers panoramic views which include The Wrekin, Long Mynd and Wenlock Edge and on a clear day as far as the hills in North Wales and the Brecon Beacons.

On Caer Caradoc summit are the remains of an ancient Bronze or Iron Age hill fort and, unlike many such sites, the remnants of the defensive ditches can easily be seen.
